What is UNIDOS?

UNIDOS is a *free, confidential program* for people who are same sex attracted and/or questioning their sexuality.

Our program provides specialised services for people and community groups from culturally and linguistically diverse and/or multicultural backgrounds (CALD). We are inclusive of all cultures and respectful of different cultural values.

We are committed to assisting our members to establish positive social contacts and to be empowered by a sense of community, where they are able to share in similar experiences in a supportive and safe environment.

“Individuality, diversity and unity”

What does UNIDOS offer?

One-to-one support through either phone or email contact, where you can ask questions and discuss issues relating to cultural identity and same sex attraction.

Information and educational sessions on positive health promotion.

Social events, art projects and group activities that provide opportunities for members to make positive social contacts and connect with each other, in a fun and friendly environment.

Workshops and discussion groups related to same sex attraction, cultural values, relationships, homophobia, sexuality issues and health and wellbeing.

Training and raising awareness in the general community and with other service providers regarding same sex attracted issues for people from multicultural backgrounds.

We understand and are familiar with the complex issues around same sex attraction within a

multicultural context. We are also aware of the potential impact these issues may have on you as a relative or friend, which is why UNIDOS also provides services for friends and family members.

Our members are from multicultural backgrounds, understand the specific issues involved and are able to relate to you and your experiences.
