

Supporting Children After Parental Separation In Schools Program

Parental separation can affect children at school

Relationships Australia (SA)'s iKiDs (I Know, I Do) program is specifically designed to support children from pre-school to 18 years, schools and parents in responding effectively to impacts and difficulties generated by parental separation.

Children who experience parental separation and divorce are generally resilient, but they are not invulnerable. Their relationships with their peers and engagement in the classroom may be negatively affected. The impact is greater on children caught in the middle of high parental conflict. Schools and teachers may also find themselves caught in the middle of parental conflict.

Over 50,000 children are affected by parental separation each year

Our education program can arrange the following support:

- Education programs and workshops for students at schools and other venues, including a puppet show for primary school children that focuses on the effects of parental separation
- Therapeutic groups for students affected by parental separation
- Workshops for teachers on supporting students from separated families
- Parenting workshops
- Information and referral pathways.
