Kids have told us that when a friendly, safe dog is in the room, they feel more relaxed.

A therapy dog can also help kids learn a lot about safe relationships, managing their feelings, and healing from hard times.



Therapy dogs are specifically trained to interact safely with children in guided, therapeutic work.

Children and young people can benefit greatly from animal assisted therapy as it helps them feel comfortable and safe, as well as helps them engage and participate in sessions.

The worker and therapy dog can meet with your child at home, at school or at a local venue.
